Millions of Americans live from one day to the next uncertain where their next meal will come from—a sad statistic that helps to reinforce the importance of the annual national Stamp Out Hunger® Food Drive, to be held this year on **Saturday, May 13th**.

The amount of food collected in a single day is overwhelming. For the last several years, over 20,000 pounds of food has been donated and collected during this Food Drive. This was the most food we ever receive in a single day. In order to collect, sort and deliver this much food, we need LOTS of help. The Watertown Food Pantry is seeking volunteers to help. We are looking for volunteers at 2 locations.....the post office beginning at 11 am and the food pantry beginning at 12 noon. At the post office, volunteers are needed to pack the food into boxes for transport to the pantry. At the pantry, we will need strong bodies to get the large post office carts into the church, to the storage room in the basement and then stack the boxes until needed.

Please remember do not donate damaged, expired or opened food products. These items need to be thrown away.

The collection portion of the food drive is normally complete by 6 pm.

If you can not help on the day of the Letter Carriers Food Drive, consider helping us out after the day is done. Those of us at the Food Pantry work for many, many weeks sorting the food by category and then sorting by expiration date.
